FIRST LESSON: Genesis 3:8-15

Immediately after Adam and Eve eat the forbidden fruit, they hide from God. Neither takes responsibility for their sin, instead blaming each other, the snake, and even God. The curse on the snake was understood by the early Church as a prophecy about Christ, Eve's offspring who would strike the serpent's head.
